

Adelbert A. Smith.

Adelbert A. Smith was born in Onandago Co., N. Y. December 27, 1841, and died at his home in Nashua, Iowa, March 14, 1897, at the age of 55 years 2 months and 13 days.

In 1845 his family moved from New York to Wisconsin, and from thence in 1879. Mr. Smith removed to Nashua, and continued to reside in this vicinity until his death. In October 1864 he enlisted as a soldier of the late war in the 1st. Wisconsin heavy artillery and served until the close of the war.

The deceased was married to Mina D. Pickle in Wisconsin in 1866. Four children were born, three of whom are now living, Geo. A. Smith, Mrs. G. W. Butler, and Addie.

The widow and children have the sincere sympathy of the community.

He was a member of the Geo. W. S. Dodge Post and they assisted at the funeral services which were held at the M. E. Church, Rev. W. B. Davis, officiating.
