AMI S. YOUNG.

Ami S. Young was born in Belvidere, Boone county, Ill., in 1846, and departed this life April 25, 1911, at the age of 65 years. When 8 years of age, he with his parents moved to Riverton, Floyd county, Iowa, where he grew to manhood. Just before the war they moved to Butler county, where he enlisted in Co. G, 27th Iowa Infantry, and served three years. In 1868 he married Miss Adelia Barkor, who survives him. Four children were born to this union, three of whom are still living, one of them having died in infancy. They are Mrs. James Cleveland, of Webster, S. D., Melvin Young, of Anacortes, Wash., and Clarence Young, who resides at home. Early in life Mr. Young accepted Christ as his Savior and united with the Baptist church, in which he made his church home until death.

The funeral was held from the Nashua Baptist church at 1 o'clock Friday afternoon, April 28, conducted by Otis L. Spurgeon, the pastor, and the burial was in Greenwood cemetery. Both the G. A. R. and W. R. C. were in attendance at the funeral and the G. A. R.'s had charge of the burial services at the cemetery.
