JOHN FELCHER

Died, at his home in this city, Tuesday, February 19, 1895, John Felcher, aged 69 years, one month and six days. Death was caused by general debility.

The deceased was born in Moira, Franklin county, New York, January 13, 1826. He was married to Soloma Noble. They came to Nashua in 1855 where he has lived ever since. Two children were born to them both of whom are now dead. His wife died in 1856.

In 1857 he was united in marriage to Eliza Welsh who still survives. Six children were born to them of whom one daughter has preceded the father to the better land. Those living are Mrs. N. O. Wait of Austin, Minn., Elbert H. of Garnaville, Mrs. M. M. Ullom of Bradford, Carl D. and William of this city. All but Mrs. Wait are here today, and she is detained by illness.

John Felcher was a veteran of the late war, serving for three years in Co. G, 27th Iowa infantry. Geo. W. S. Dodge Post, G. A. R., will give him a patriot's burial today.

The funeral services were held at the M. E. church at 2 o'clock this afternoon, Dr. Smith officiating. The interment was at Oak Hill.
