

Obituary.

EZERIAH HERRINGTON was born near Farmersville, Western Canada in the year 1837 and died at his home in Bradford, Ia., April 24, 1904. He enlisted in the Civil War, Jan. 28, 1862, served 3 years, 3 months and 11 days. He was married to Parmelia Stuart at Beloit, Wis. in the year 1866, on the 18th day of January.

There were born to them four children; Mrs. Nellie Thompson of Little Falls, Minn., Mrs. Nettie Baldwin of Port Ripley, Minn., Mrs. Maryette Granger of Nashua who died August 23, 1901 and one daughter who died in infancy. Besides he leaves a wife and one grandchild who has made her home with them for some time.

He united with the Baptist church in 1887 of which he has been a faithful member. He has been in poor health for the past three years.

The funeral services were held at the residence in Bradford, Rev. Shear officiating and the Geo. W. S. Dodge Post, G. A. R. took charge of the burial ceremony. A large number gathered to pay their last respects to a good neighbor and loyal citizen.
