LLOYD WARDEL.

Died, at the home of his son, Robert, three miles northwest of Nashua, Lloyd Wardel, on Monday, at the age of 71 years and 7 days.

Mr. Wardel was born in Indiana Jan. 1, 1829. When Lincoln called for volunteers, in 1860, to put down the rebellion, he willingly responded, enlisting in Company E, Ninety-sixth Illinois Volunteers. The funeral was held from the home of his son, where he died, Wednesday at 10 o'clock a. m., Rev. Sutton officiating, and the remains were interred in the Beck cemetery.
