

### Obituary.

Robert Beck was born in Gallia Co. Ohio June 22, 1840. He came to Floyd county, Iowa, with his fathers family about forty years ago. He enlisted into Co G 27th Iowa infantry, Aug. 1, 1860, and served with the regiment until the 9th of April 1864, at which time he was wounded in the temple, resulting in the loss of his left eye, at the battle of Pleasant Hill. He was a prisoner of war until June 22, 1864 and was discharged on account of his wound May 25, 1865. About twenty-five years ago he married Agnes M. Wert. He leaves two children, Gertie Sanderson and Pearl Beck. Mr Beck was one of the first to join Geo. W. S. Dodge Post and has been a faithful member. He died Nov 29, 1890. His funeral was held at his home in Riverton township on Sunday, Nov 30th, 1890, under auspices of the Post of which he was a member. Rev. N. Fay preached the funeral sermon. The attendance at the funeral services was very large. Mr Beck had a large circle of friends as the assemblage testified. He will be missed by his family, friends and comrades, and the community generally.
