HENRY WALLESER, proprietor wagon and blacksmith shop. Greenwood, Iowa, established the business in 1874; was born in Baden, Germany, in 1848 and at the age of two years came to America with his parents and located in Philadelphia, Pa. where he remained until 1855 when he removed to Claytor county, Iowa, and in 1870 moved to Chickasaw county and located in Nashua where he was engaged in the foundry for some time. He served in the army one year and four months, in Company E, 27th Iowa Volunteer Infantry and was honorably discharged and mustered out at Montgomery, Ala. Was united in marriage to Annie F. Deckman of Clayton county.
