

UNCLE CHARLEY CASWELL GONE

Aged Veteran Dropped Dead in His
Garden Tuesday Afternoon. Fu-
neral at 10 a. m. Thursday

The people of this community were shocked and grieved on Tuesday afternoon to hear that "Uncle" Charley Caswell had died suddenly at about 2 p. m.

Although an invalid for the past five years, "Uncle" Charley had been feeling pretty good and was around most of the time. That afternoon he went to the garden to direct the setting of some plants when he suddenly sank to the ground and expired a few moments later.

The death of Mr. Caswell will be widely mourned, for his cheerful disposition, and his old time ability with the file had made him a conspicuous figure at all patriotic gatherings in years gone by. He was a veteran of the Civil war.

The funeral will be held from the home on Thursday at 10 a. m. and burial will be in Greenwood cemetery.
