

**Obituary.**

William Hebard was born in Rutland, Vermont, Dec. 22, 1824, and died at his home in Nashua, Nov. 29, 1910, at the ripe age of almost 86 years. Mr. Hebard came with his parents to Milwaukee and went from there to Jefferson county, Wisconsin, in 1828. On May 9, 1847, he was united in marriage to Miss Killiza White. To this union three children were born, only one of whom is living, William D. Hebard, of Augusta, Wis.

In 1861 Mr. Hebard enlisted in Co. E 4th Wis. Reg. at Jefferson, Wis., and served during the war.

In 1865 he moved to the vicinity of Nashua and later into Nashua where he has lived until his death.

Mr. Hebard was well liked by his neighbors, and those who came in contact with him were his friends. His business relations were all pleas-

ant and agreeable, as those with whom he dealt gladly testify. He has represented some of the Iowa insurance companies for over 20 years.

He leaves to mourn his loss a loving wife, a son, Wm. D., a host of friends and relatives.
