### Henry E. Knapp

Henry E. Knapp, a former resident of this community, died at the Old Soldiers' Home at Marshalltown on Wednesday, night, April 17, 1929, at the age of 87 years, death being due to heart trouble.

Mr. Knapp was born March 18, 1842, in Illinois, and was a member of Co. A., 95th Regiment of the Illinois Infantry Volunteers during the Civil War.

He was married to Julia N. Gary on Dec. 18, 1872, at Fredericksburg. To this union seven children were born, one of whom, together with his wife, preceded him in death.

The surviving children are Mrs. S. P. Wilson, Mrs. L. W. Eckstein, Mrs. Mike Zwanziger, Mrs. A. C. Winterburn, Frank T. Knapp and Mrs. H. E. Reimer.

Deceased engaged in farming near Greene for many years, and had made his residence at the Soldiers Home for the past 32 years.

of his daughter, Mrs. Mike Zwanziger, on Thursday, and funeral services were held at the M. E. church at 2 p. m., Saturday, Rev. E. E. Clements officiating. Interment was in Greenwood cemetery.
